What is this Policy for?

This policy is for this website www.webdevelopmentandhosting.co.uk, served by WDH IT SERVICES and informs users of our website what cookies are, why we use them, and provides information to help our website users manage them.

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files usually consisting of letters and numbers, that are saved to the user's computer's hard drive that track, save and store information about the user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server to provide the users with a tailored experience within this website.

Types of cookies

The International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) groups cookies into the following categories:

- strictly necessary cookies
- performance cookies
- functionality and targeting cookies.

Strictly necessary cookies enable you to move around the website and use features like signing into our control panel and ordering via our shopping basket system.

Performance cookies collect information about how you use our website and are stored on your computer or device in-between browser sessions.

Functionality and targeting cookies are stored on your computer or device in-between browser sessions. They are used to remember settings or preferences to help improve your experience next time you visit our site. Some of these cookies are provided by approved third parties.

How does our website use cookies?

This website uses cookies to better the users experience while visiting the website. Some cookies are essential for the site to function and we enable these cookies automatically when you visit. Some cookies allow us to provide the services and features that are most likely to meet your needs, and to customise our service to make your experience easier and quicker.

This website uses strictly necessary cookies for keeping track of user input and progressing through the shopping basket.

We do not use strictly necessary cookies to:

- Gather any personal information about you or your Internet settings
- Remember your preferences or store any information about you beyond your current visit.

This website uses performance cookies to help us improve how our website works, understand what areas of our website are of most interest to our customers and learn about the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns. All this helps us bring you the best possible experience when visiting our website.



We use performance cookies to:

- Provide statistics about how our website is used
- See how effective our marketing campaigns are

We do not use performance cookies to:

- Gather any personal information

Some of these cookies are provided by approved third parties, but we don't allow third parties to use the cookies for any purpose other than those listed above.

We use functionality and targeting cookies to:

- Display offers on webdevelopmentandhosting.co.uk that we think you might be interested in
- Share information with partners who provide a service on our website. The information is only shared to provide the service, product or function and is not used for any other purpose.

Some functional and targeting cookies are managed for us by third parties. We don't allow the third party to use the cookies for any purpose other than those listed above.

This website also uses tracking software to monitor its visitors to better understand how they use it. This software is provided by Google Analytics which uses cookies to track visitor usage. The software will save a cookie to your computer's hard drive to track and monitor your engagement and usage of the website, but will not store, save or collect personal information. How we help our website users manage cookies?

Where applicable this website uses a cookie control system allowing the user on their first visit to the website to allow or disallow the use of cookies on their computer / device. This complies with recent legislation requirements for websites to obtain explicit consent from users before leaving behind or reading files such as cookies on a user's computer / device. Users are advised that if they wish to deny the use and saving of cookies from this website on to their computers hard drive they should take necessary steps within their web browsers security settings to block all cookies from this website and its external serving vendors.

Using browser settings to manage cookies

Use the help feature on your internet browser will tell you how to stop your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie and how to disable cookies altogether.

Because enabling all cookies means you'll always get the best out of webdevelopmentandhosting.co.uk we do advise that you leave them turned on. For example, if you choose not to allow all cookies, some features of our site will not operate as intended.



If you decide not to enable cookies, or delete all cookies from your browser, you will be asked if you would like to enable them when you next visit our site.
